






Internal Stakeholder Considerations

- Maintain Clean and Safe Parks



Proposed Lake Erie Water Trail – Cuyahoga County

A <u>water trail</u> is a recreational boating route along a waterway with strategically located access points similar to a hiking trail or bikeway.



Partners include the cities of Bay Village, Rocky River, Lakewood, Cleveland, and Euclid.

Euclid Creek Lakefront

- Continue to improve access to beach level – link pier to Villa Angela beach
- Increase habitat and continue to add green infrastructure / improve stormwater
- Provide additional shelter / play area / event space
- Pursue the trail linking lakefront to main portion of Euclid Creek Reservation
- Watch activity on neighboring parcels / partnership potential

- Canal Basin Park / Forum Pavilion






