## Hinckley Reservation – Whipp's Ledges Virtual Scavenger Hunt

- Many ferns find ways to thrive without a lot of soil. Find some ferns growing on the rocks.
- Find something yellow along the trail.
- What other trail runs through this area? Find evidence of it.
- □ What is the name of the rock formations that make up these ledges?
- This type of rock weathers in interesting ways. Find some evidence of what geologists call honeycomb weathering.
- Find a tree that has smooth gray bark. What kind of tree is it?
- Find a spring wildflower along the trail.
- Take a picture of something that best describes you or your family. Be creative!

## Hinckley Reservation – Hinckley Lake Loop Trail Virtual Scavenger Hunt

- Ohio's largest rodent is a resident of Hinckley Lake. Find evidence of this and name the animal.
- Find a sign that describes a plant that most people try to avoid.
- If it's a warm day, look for turtles sunning themselves on logs and take a photo.
- Find an animal track and name the animal.
- Find two different wildflowers popping up along the trail
- Find the tree that has "knees" coming up through the water. Do you know what kind of tree this is?
- Find a woodpecker hole.
- Ducks, geese, herons and cormorants are some of the birds that call Hinckley Lake home. Try your best to take a photo of one.
  - Use a stick to draw a picture in the sand and take a photo of it!
